



## CHAMPION CARDS - ACTIVATIONS

### Competition Collectables

Pick one grade/age group and either 1 or 2 days – like 2 Saturdays in a row. Have “champions” roaming courts giving out Cards to Champions.

- a. One person collects all 5 cards gets a free prize and/or goes in draw to win prize
- b. Club/School with the most cards collected (ratioed to number of teams) gets a free prize and/or goes in draw to win something

Region wide: All club/school winners go in Zone draw to win Mystics/Stars at their training session

### Umpire Tool

Umpires have stock of cards when go out on court – they can give to sideline for good role models OR to those that need to hear the messaging. Consider the positive verses negative connotations.

Umpire coaches/mentors that are courtside give out as above

### Club/School meetings or coaching/umpire workshops

Use as teaching tool for LTG (balance is better) messaging through workshops or hui. Give a group a card and have them unpack how they might use these sayings to role model OR have them act out a scenario of when the sayings might be used in a netball context

### Coach Champions:

If Centres have identified some Champions give them stock to hand out to sidelines, coaches or players they see role modeling positive behaviours. Say thank you – You’re a Champion!

**Centre Volunteers:** Have cards on hand so when roaming courts or called to a court can give out to those that are Champions, and those that need to learn to be Champions

### Competing Sidelines

One teams’ sideline evaluate the other and give out cards to the best champions of the game
