

NORTHERN NETBALL ZONE

Criteria for awarding a service award

A Netball Northern Zone Service Award will recognize an individual who has made significant contributions to the sport of netball within the Northern Zone.

Pre- requisite for nomination

For a person to be nominated they must have contributed significantly to the sport of netball in the Northern Zone for at least 5 years in a largely voluntary capacity (paid work can be included, but the emphasis is on voluntary work).

Procedure for Nomination

Nomination may be made by a Netball Club or Centre, the Northern Zone Board or a person considered to have the requisite qualifications.

A nomination must be made on the official form available from the Netball Northern Zone website.

All relevant information should be provided (including dates if relevant) as the assessment of the nomination will be based on the material supplied by the nominator.

Information should consist of

- Details of the nominee
- Information detailing any positions held and years of service (dates included)
- Paid employment maybe included if it relates to the sport, but on its own will not be sufficient and must be supported by other service
- Information must be able to be verified
- Information must be informative, accurate and detailed.

Consideration of Nomination

The Netball Northern Zone Service Award Committee, appointed by the Zone Board, shall consider the application and determine whether the award should be recommended and will advise the nominator of the decision.

Approval of Nomination

The Netball Northern Zone Annual General Meeting shall consider a recommendation and a two thirds majority of those entitled to vote will decide if the award should be ratified. A Service award badge shall be presented to a successful nominee.

Closing Date

Nominations close at 5pm on Wednesday 9 March 2022.
