NETBALL NEW ZEALAND

For many of us, this time of year is all about reviewing the recently completed netball season and planning for the next 12 months – as well as continuing with the business of the day! It is also an opportunity to take stock and reflect on the many achievements.

With Covid-19 playing such a prominent role over the past couple of years, being able to get through a full season of largely uninterrupted netball feels like a fantastic achievement in itself!

At the recent Netball New Zealand Connections Conference, we heard from a number of great speakers. Sport NZ CEO, Raelene Castle noted that levels of participation in New Zealand have been declining. This was repeated at the InterAktive Live Workshop this week, where it was noted that on average Aucklanders in particular, are less active that the rest of the country. One of the key barriers to participation for young women is uniforms, and not feeling comfortable in having to wear certain clothing.

A question for our netball community is whether we are providing an environment where our participants feel comfortable? The main reason for uniforms is to distinguish one team from the other. If we can do this with bibs in netball, can we be more flexible with what is worn underneath?

I encourage each of our Centres to consider this issue and decide if your current uniform rules are fit for purpose. Look out for Netball NZ's new uniform guidelines coming out to Centres before Christmas. If the research says that uniforms are a barrier to participation, can we make changes so that this barrier is removed?

We also heard about the importance of the youth voice in the decision-making process – a "no decision about us without us" mentality. At the zone we are looking at ways we can hear from our young people more often and in an authentic way. I would encourage each Centre to consider this as well, and I know many already do, which is great.

Finally, a reminder that season memberships are now on sale for both the MG Mystics and Robinhood Stars. Get in behind and support your favourite ANZ Premiership team with a season membership – makes for a great Christmas present as well!
