SPORTS TUTOR - NEW PLAYER/UMPIRE MODULE

Sport Tutor is now up and running! Sport Tutor is a tried and tested online learning management tool in the sports industry, used by many codes and managed through Sport New Zealand.

This means that you can now access the <u>New Player/Umpire Module</u> which replaces the Netball NZ centre theory test. This module is the first step towards the Centre Umpire award or a pre-requisite for some netball centres for their player umpires. This module helps new and player umpires understand some of the rules of netball as well as some practical techniques to enhance their umpiring.

UMPIRE ZONE THEORY EXAM

On Thursday 1 April, applications for the Zone Theory Exam to be held on Monday 17th May on the Sport Tutor platform will open with a link on the Netball New Zealand website https://www.netballnz.co.nz/get-involved/umpiring. On the website there will be a "How to Guide" which will walk you through the registration process. A copy of that "How to Guide" has been sent to the netball centres.

Sport Tutor will enable us to develop our exam experience further, although in 2021 the experience will be similar to that used in 2020.
