NETBALLSMART

The first NetballSmart Prep'N'Play programme was successfully ran at Howick Pakuranga Netball Center through March. This programme was developed with the aim to get Players fit for the Netball season, build strength, core control and stability, and develop good Netball movement patterns. ACC statistics show that between the months of April and May there is a 300% spike in Netball related injuries. This programme is designed to help transition players into the season.

NetballSmart has grown significantly beyond the NetballSmart Dynamic Warm up, it is a comprehensive holistic Injury Prevention programme (IPP) connecting with not only coaches but also players, parents, officials, and governance.

Ongoing exposure of content and messaging to the wider Netball population is vital to the long-term success of this programme. In the Northern Zone the NetballSmart team has now grown to include two NetballSmart activators based at Papakura and Whāngarei Netball Centres.

Tracey Spence the Netball Smart Centre Activator based at Papakura Netball Centre has led the promotion and delivery of the Netball Smart Power Warmup for all of members over three grading day events. The Power Warm-up was also a huge component of Representative Trials over two weeks educating those that are new to the program.

NetballSmart has been designed to ensure players become "physically capable and competent movers". This means that they have the fundamental movement skills, the Netball Specific movement skills and the strength needed to play the game.

Players that are physically capable and competent have more time on court, are less likely to get injured and therefore constantly improving their performance.
