### Funding Landscape – Overview

- Covid has caused considerable disruption to Class 4 Gaming.
- Trusts are forecasting as much as 50% down on pre-covid levels.
- More competition for reduced funding available.
- But there is still funding and netball can get its share.

#### Grant Funders – What do they like to fund?

- Class 4 Gaming check websites before applying
  - There is variation from Trust to Trust as to what they will fund
  - Main split is between those that do wages/salaries and those that don't
- Think local what Trusts operate in your area? Go to them first.
- Get the timing right check closing dates allow 6-8 weeks.

### Council / Local Board Funding

- Again check websites. Councils have funding opportunities, usually in smaller amounts.
- What council are you in?
- Auckland Council also has local board funding
- Do you know your local board? Do you have more than one?
  - Make a point of presenting to your local board once per year
  - Tell them what your priorities are particularly if you are situated on Council land, or if you have a facilities that need upgrading
