Whatever your choice of fundraising the basic rules remain the same "BE PREPARED". One of the most time consuming aspects of funding is the information gathering process. Whether your project is large or small you will always need the same basic information about your organization.




What do I want funding for? Where do I apply?

Use the Sport NZ Funding Directory to find out who the local funders are, and if they fund what your organization needs.


RST- Local Community Funding workshops for clubs & centres A List "Power Words"
Read & understand the funders strategies
Align to the funders strategies
Provide clubs with cover letter, resolution and organization history templates and examples.



For clubs and centres who are not familiar with funding, we recommend attending a CLM Funding workshop first. These provide an understanding of who funders are, and what the end to end application processes looks like.

RST's who deliver funding workshops: Sport Waitakere, Harbour Sport, Sport Northland Templates and Examples help clubs to be able to 'tell their story':
WHY does your organization need funding?
WHO will it benefit and how?
WHAT is the impact if you don't receive funding?

Members support in your applications is an important element of the funding process.


Don't underestimate the value of 'The participants voice'. These comments may be contained in letters of support, thank you notes, general comments in club meetings or through surveys.



What do I need to include in my Cover Letter?

- A brief description of your organisation and the work that you do.
- A summary of the project including total project cost and other sources of funding.
- The specific purpose of your grant application and the community that will benefit from the funding.
- Include any relevant dates i.e. events / travel / salary timeframes etc.





Building relationships with local funders and stakeholders is essential. A netball centre and club can Thido this in various ways: ganisations for supporting

Contact the funding administrator and set up a meet and greet

Invite funders to your centre events i:e Opening Day, Prizegiving's, Special Awards, Rep tournaments etc.

Work in collaboration with other sports codes/user groups for joint funding where practical.

Acknowledge Funders for their generous contributions every time!

Give clubs a hand up with funding applications.

Provide funding close off date reminders & quote request reminders in weekly newsletters,

Have an open door policy for clubs to contact you and ask 'Where do I start if I want to apply for funding'

Organize with your local community sport organization to offer funding workshops for new clubs.

Group clubs into phases, and deliver targeted sessions on the various processes in a funding application. i:e if you have 4 clubs who want to become incorporated societies group them and deliver one info night together.
